Partial Schedule of Rates and Charges

Effective March 1, 2008

Bi-monthly Service Charge

Bills are rendered on a bi-monthly basis. The service charge for each water meter is as follows:

5/8 in.	\$31.00
3/4 in.	\$37.00
1 in.	\$55.00
1 1/2 in.	\$95.10
2 in.	\$145.10
3 in.	\$335.40
4 in.	\$515.60
6 in.	\$1016.30

Conservation Based Tiered Quantity Rate

1 unit = 100 cubic feet (ft³) (748 gallons)

For 5/8" domestic meters

1-8 units	\$2.71 per 100 ft ³ (748 gallons).
9-30 units.....	\$5.17 per 100 ft ³ (748 gallons).
31 units and above...	\$8.96 per 100 ft ³ (748 gallons).

For 3/4" and 1" domestic meters

1-13 units.....	\$2.71 per 100 ft ³ (748 gallons).
14-49 units.....	\$5.17 per 100 ft ³ (748 gallons).
50 units and above...	\$8.96 per 100 ft ³ (748 gallons).

Non-domestic (all sizes)\$4.27 per 100 ft³.

Service charge applies regardless of the amount of water consumed. Service charge is prorated if service is discontinued or established. Charges continue in current customer name until the District is notified of intent to discontinue service.

Private Fire Service Rates

Bi-monthly charge based on the size of service:

2 in.....	\$5.00
3 in.....	\$10.00
4 in.....	\$18.80
6 in.....	\$39.20
8 in.....	\$56.40

Additional Charges

Customer returned checks (NSF).....	\$10.00
Delinquent charge (48-Hour Notice).....	\$10.00
Reestablishment of service.....	\$40.00
Water turn on after normal business hours....add	\$60.00

Important Notice

A \$10.00 delinquent charge is added to a delinquent water bill if it becomes necessary to deliver a 48-Hour Notice/Door Hanger which is only delivered after a regular bill and past due notice have been previously sent. This policy is in place so the majority of our customers who pay their bills on time are not subsidizing the cost for increased handling, processing, delivery cost, and materials these accounts generate.

Connection and Meter Charges

Charges for installation of new Domestic meters are payable in advance and are as follows:

5/8 in.....	\$3,344.00
1 in.....	\$3,419.00
1 1/2 in. and larger.....	Actual Cost
2 in. Fire Service.....	\$4,046.00

Charges for installation of 2-inch Fire Protection Service/Domestic Combination meters are payable in advance and are as follows:

Meter Size	Charge
5/8 in. Domestic Service/Fire Protection.....	\$5,008.00
1 in. Domestic Service/Fire Protection.....	\$5,135.00
1 1/2 in. or larger.....	Actual Cost

Storage and Transmission Charges

In addition to the Connection and Meter Charges there is an established Storage and Transmission Charge based on size of meter. All fees are payable upon application for a new service. Effective January 1, 2006. Standard Size Meter Charge

5/8 in.....	\$7,000.00
1 in.....	\$17,500.00

Additional charges are applicable for installation and/or service of: Fire Hydrants, Fire Services, Bulk Water, and Relocation of an existing meter.

Water Demand Offset Charges

Applicants for new service must comply with the Water Demand Offset program. This requires new development to offset projected water demand by retrofitting fixtures or turf at existing properties within the District service area. Applicants are responsible for bearing the costs of the retrofit(s) up to \$660 per high-efficiency toilet, \$1000 per urinal or up to \$2 a square foot for artificial turf. Requirements may be minimized by purchasing higher than normal efficient fixtures and appliances for the new development. See "Green Credit" and Water Demand Offset fact sheet for details.
