REBATE CREDIT APPLICATION

Customer agreement and requirements

- This rebate program provides financial assistance to Soquel Creek Water District (SqCWD) customers wishing to conserve water by doing one or several of the following: replace high water use grass with low water use grass or plants, install high-efficiency clothes washers, toilets, a weather-based irrigation controller, rain catchment system /cistern, convert spray irrigation to drip irrigation or replace broken sprinkler heads.
- No rebate will exceed the cost of the item purchased.
- Rebate credits will be paid to the Soquel Creek Water District customer of record only. Customer's account must be in good standing to receive a credit. Balance of credit will be mailed to the customer upon closing of the account. Allow four weeks from the date of inspection for processing of your credit. The credit will appear on a subsequent water bill.
- Installation of the device, appliance or fixture is the sole responsibility of the applicant, as is determination of the adequacy and compatibility of the existing plumbing system.
- Fixtures, appliances, sprinklers and or grasses must be installed at a location served by the Soquel Creek Water District.
- Funding for rebate credit is limited and will be available until funds are depleted. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis, provided the application meets all qualifying criteria. There is no implied or expressed guarantee that funding will be available at the time the application is processed.
- An original, dated sales receipt must be provided. Rebate credits do not apply to sales tax or installation charges. Only the grass replacement rebate and the drip irrigation rebate allow for contractor installation costs to be included.
- Soquel Creek Water District does not endorse specific brands, products or dealers; nor does it guarantee materials or workmanship; acceptance of such is customer's responsibility.
- Soquel Creek Water District assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage that may occur to an applicant's property as a result of participation in this program. Due to circumstances beyond its control, the District cannot guarantee that installation of rebated fixtures or plants will result in lower utility costs.
- The applicant is solely responsible for the proper disposal of all materials associated with the installation of the conservation fixtures and plant material (including, but not limited to, soil, grass, irrigation piping, synthetic turf remnants, etc.), and the Soquel Creek Water District assumes no responsibility or liability. Please recycle materials when possible.
- A representative of SqCWD must be permitted to inspect the property to verify proper installation.
