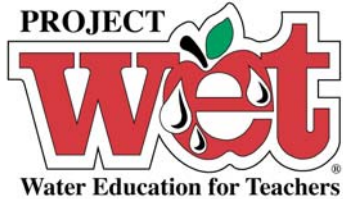


Water Education for Teachers!
