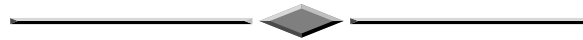

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed Bids will be publicly opened, examined, and announced by the Soquel Creek Water District, Santa Cruz County, California, on January 15, 2014, at the hour of 2:00 PM and reported at the next regular District Board Meeting.

Bids may be delivered or mailed to the Secretary of the Board, 5180 Soquel Drive, Soquel California 95073 or Post Office Box 1550, Capitola, California 95010.

Bids shall be made in accordance with the prevailing hourly rate of per diem wages for this locality and project as determined by the Director of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code §1770 et seq., a copy of which is on file at the District Office, 5180 Soquel Drive. Labor Code §1770 et seq. is made a part of this Notice by reference as though fully set forth herein.

The work will consist of mobilization and set up of two 18,000+ gallon baker tanks, removing existing well piping and equipment, pre- and post-rehabilitation well videos, wire brushing, chemical treatment, surging and swabbing, zone pumping before and after well chlorination, test pumping, installation of a replacement permanent pump, well chlorination/disinfection, demobilization and all other incidental work. All work will be within Soquel, California.

This project is subject to the requirements of Section 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code requiring the payment of prevailing wages, the training of apprentices and compliance with other applicable requirements. District has on file at its main office access to prevailing rate of per diem wages to be paid to all applicable workers. The prevailing wage rate determinations on file with District shall be made available to all interested parties upon reasonable request during normal business hours. Prevailing wage information may also be obtained via the internet at: www.dir.ca.gov. This project is subject to other Labor Compliance Requirements of California Labor Code and contractors/will be required to submit all required documentation as a prerequisite to progress and final payments.

Work will be done and progress payments made in cash in accordance with the specifications approved by the Board of Directors on December 17, 2013 and the Standard Specifications and Standard Plans adopted by the Board of Directors August 2, 1994.

The Board of Directors reserves the privilege of rejecting any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid, or in the bidding process.


No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of thirty (30) days after bids are opened, within which time an award will be made.
